



# A.Y. McDonald Mfg. Co. Small Wrap/Patch Repair Clamps

Installation Instructions

## Preparation:

1. Check diameter of pipe to make sure you are using the correct size clamp.
2. Clean pipe to remove dirt and corrosion from the surface.
3. Place marks on the pipe to reference the leak. Use these marks to assure that the clamp is properly centered.

## Installation:

1. Back off the nuts to the ends of the bolts, **but do not remove them**. Separate the clamp.
2. Center the clamp gasket over the area that needs repaired. Make sure the clamp gasket extends well past the damaged area.
3. Relocate the bolt heads securely into their receiving lugs. Tighten bolts to torque range listed on repair clamp.
4. Pressure test for leaks before backfilling.
